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INTRODUCTION

The Master of Education (M.Ed) programme is a two year professional programme in the field of teacher education which aims at preparing teacher educators and other education professionals including curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, planners, administrators, supervisors and researchers. The completion of the programme shall lead to M.Ed degree with specialisation in Elementary Education and Secondary/Sr.secondary Education. The programme is designed to provide opportunities for student teachers to extend as well as deepen their knowledge and understanding of education, and also develop research capacities, leading to specialization in Elementary Education &Secondary Education. A field internship to the area of teacher's training programme at elementary level and secondary level is organised during the course.

After the completion of the course, the student teacher would be able:

- to develop professional attitudes, values and interests needed to function as a teacher educator

- to generate an awareness cum practical exposure to the prospective teacher educator as a content creator
- to get acquainted with the content, and organisation of pre-service teacher education curriculum, infrastructure and resources needed, and the issues and problems related to teacher preparation.

- to design in-service teacher professional development program/activities based on the needs of teachers
- to gain insight and reflect on the concept and the status of pre-service and in-service teacher education
- to critically examine the role and contribution of various agencies and regulating bodies in enhancing the quality of teacher education.

- to master the methods and techniques of developing competencies, commitments and performance skills of teachers.
