It should be sent to mail id: <a href="mailto:iahctvm2018@gmail.com">iahctvm2018@gmail.com</a> on or before 31st October 2018 so that the abstracts can be brought to a booklet. Abstracts received after 31st October may not get a place in the booklet. Paper presentation in the IAHC Conference is open to members only. Non-members can avail of annual membership of the IAHC if need be. International conference is open to all.
- ii. Only members/participants who send their registration fee on or before 31<sup>st</sup> October 2018 will be considered as the official delegates of the conference and **the facility of food and accommodation will be restricted to them**.

Last minute submission of abstract and registration fee are not encouraged and in such cases the participants will have to arrange their own accommodation.

- iii. There will be an open session in which scholars/researchers can present papers on the subjects of their specialization.
- iv. Every presenter will get 10 minutes for presentation and another 5 minutes for discussion.
