RULES FOR THE AWARD OF UNIVERSITY MERIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE MA DEGREE COURSE IN GERMAN

(Revised as per the decision of the Meeting of the Syndicate held on 06/02/2018)

- 1. There shall be One (1) Merit Scholarship for MA Degree Course in German of the value of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) per annum.
- 2. Candidates for the award of the Scholarship should possess a First Class in the Diploma examination in German or secured 60% or more marks under Part II (German) of the BA/BSc Examination held immediately preceding the award of the scholarship. In the absence of eligible candidates from the immediately preceding University Examination, candidates who had obtained First Class in a Previous Examination at the First appearance may also be considered.
- 3. These scholarship shall be awarded annually by the Syndicate to the student who secure the highest percentage of marks from among those who have secured a First Class in the Diploma Examination in German and/or secured 60% or more marks under Part II (German) of the BA/BSc course.
- 4. Only those candidates who have qualified for the Diploma examination in German or BA/BSc Examination as the case may be at the first appearance and immediately after the completion of the course in the minimum period prescribed without interruption are eligible for consideration for the award of above scholarship.
- 5. The Scholarship is tenable for the duration of the course.
- 6. If the scholarship awarded to a student falls vacant, the vacant scholarship shall be awarded to the candidate next in rank as per rules. In the event of there being no candidate eligible for the award in any year, those scholarships may be re-allotted by the Syndicate for other MA (languages)course for that year.
- 7. In deciding the cases of awards of Scholarship to students who obtain the same marks, their performance at the Bachelor's degree Examination shall be taken into consideration.

- 8. The Principals of Colleges/Heads of the University Departments shall be drawing officers for the disbursement of the scholarship. The annual value of the scholarship shall be paid on a Principals/Heads basis in advance to the The Principals/Heads of the Department Departments concerned. Office the payee's receipts for the first forward to this quarter along with the bills for the second quarter and so on. The bills for the four quarters shall be forwarded by the Principals/Heads of Departments and payments made to them by the University in the months of June, September, December and March every year. The principals/Heads of Departments shall retain the amounts with them and make payments in arrears to the students at the close of each It shall be the responsibility of the Principals/Heads of Departments disbursement see that the are made to in accordance with the rules. Any unspent balance the Principals/Heads of Departments at the end of each quarter shall be remitted to the Kerala University Fund.
- 9. Students who belongs to the Kerala State and are studying in any of the Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala or in the University Department immediately after passing the qualifying examination conducted by the University of Kerala alone are eligible for the awards.
- 10. shall held scholarship not be concurrently with any other scholarships Welfare **Scholarships** offered except by State/Central Government. The continuance of the scholarship for vear shall depend upon the satisfactory each progress and conduct of the holders thereof.
- 11. The scholarship shall not be held for more than one year in the same class and shall be discontinued in the event of failure at a University Examination.
- 12. The scholarship may be held along with fee concessions, if any, enjoyed by the holders.
- 13. Any change in these Rules shall be made by the Syndicate.
