Online Applications are invited from qualified candidates for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor (on contract basis) in all Teaching Departments of the University of Kerala for anticipated vacancies.

Terms and Conditions

1. Nature of Appointment : Contract basis for a period of eleven months or until a permanent faculty is appointed to the post, whichever is earlier.

2. Essential Qualifications : i) Master's Degree with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. A relaxation of 5% marks is allowed to SC/ST candidates.

ii) National Eligibility Test (NET) for the appointment as Assistant Professor/Ph.D. Degree in the subject concerned.

3. Age : Not more than 50 years as on 01.01.2026 (usual relaxation in the upper age limit shall be allowed in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST, OBC Communities)

4. Remuneration : A consolidated monthly pay of ₹45,000/- (Rupees Forty Five Thousand Only).

5. Application Fee : ₹500/- [for SC/ST candidates - ₹250/-]

6. Mode of Submitting Applications : Candidates should apply online by logging on to www.recruit.keralauniversity.ac.in

7. Last date for submitting applications : **31.08.2026**



NOTE:

1. All candidates should have a valid e-mail ID. All the communications will be given through e-mail only.
2. Shortlisted candidates after scrutiny of applications, will be invited for interview, for which they must appear with all essential certificates/documents (including mark list) in original along with self attested copies. The date of the interview will be communicated via email to the shortlisted candidates.
3. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Universities other than University of Kerala, should produce eligibility certificate obtained from this University at the time of interview.
4. Those who are eligible for reservation should produce necessary documents.
5. Candidates who are employed should produce a No Objection Certificate from their employer at the time of interview.
6. Other documents such as evidences of peer reviewed journals/teaching experience/post doctoral fellowship should be produced at the time of interview.
7. Hard copy of the application need not be sent to the University.
