The Syndicate meeting started at 10.00 AM itself. Adv.G. Muraleedharan Pillai, Member Syndicate raised objection for convening the meeting on the grounds that the Model Code of Conduct is in force and the University has not received permission to conduct the same from the competent authority. Dr.Pramod N., and Dr.S. Nazeeb, Members Syndicate were of the opinion that all the items proposed in the First Agenda served to the members should be considered without any restrictions. Two other Syndicate Members Dr.Vinodkumar T.G. Nair and Sri. P.S. Gopakumar, Members Syndicate dissented and requested the chair to continue the meeting with the items affecting students. Most of the remaining members preferred to agree with the opinion of Adv.G. Muraleedharan Pillai. The Chair, Vice-Chancellor asked the house whether the meeting can be continued with important agenda items affecting the students. Upon this, Adv.G.Muraleedharan Pillai reiterated that without written permission from the competent authority, the meeting should not be continued to which all Syndicate Members except Sri. P.S. Gopakumar and Sri.Vinodkumar T.G. Nair, agreed. Since majority of the members are against continuation of the same, the Chair dissolved the meeting and decided to convene the meeting after obtaining clearance from the Screening Committee of the Election authority.
