Item No.01. Meeting of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning and Development held on 05.09.2022– Minutes – Approval of - reg.

(PL.G)

A meeting of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning and Development was held at 10.30 a.m on 05.09.2022 in the Syndicate room.

It may be noted that the Committee made a detailed negotiation with PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd., Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram (L1), regarding **the setting up of Translational Research and Innovation Centre** at the University of Kerala (TRIC-KU) [ITEM No.03] and PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd. was directed to re-examine the bid amount quoted by the firm for the project, as the rate is not affordable.

Then the firm conveyed their willingness to reduce the offered rate to Rs. 30Lakh (Rupees thirty lakh only). Further, the meeting directed the University Engineer to offer remarks on the revised rate amounting to Rs. 30 Lakh (Rupees thirty lakh only) for the project, quoted by PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd.

Accordingly, the University Engineer has offered remarks as follows:

"The rough estimate for the construction submitted by the previous Consultant who prepared the preliminary design was Rs.15 Crores. The construction cost as per the estimate prepared based on DPAR 2019 comes to Rs.26,92,50,000/-. As per GO (P) No. 67/2021/Fin dated 28-04-2021, the Government has fixed the guidelines for the selection procedure of accredited agencies in which the charges fixed for Investigation, Planning, Design, Preparation of Drawings, Detailed Estimate and

DPR for works costing above Rs.5 crore is 1.5% of the project cost. Moreover as per the scope of work, the firm should also periodically supervise the work in the angle of the Architecture to ensure that the project is being carried out as per architectural design.

If we are following the same guidelines for appointing the Consultant for this project, the maximum consultancy fee @ 1.5% of the project cost as per DPAR estimate comes to Rs.40,38,750/-(excluding GST). The negotiated offer from M/s PEMS Engineering Consultant is within the maximum eligible fee as per the above GO.

Considering the above, the offer from M/s PEMS Engineering Consultant at Rs.30,00,000/- \pm GST is recommendable. Regarding the task period, suitable decision may be taken from the higher ups."

Considering the above remarks of the University Engineer, the meeting **recommended to** approve the revised rate amounting to Rs.30Lakh (Rupees thirty lakh only) for the project, quoted by PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd. and also to request the Vice Chancellor to approve this recommendation and to accord administrative sanction for the proposal, by exercising the powers vested under section 10(13) of the KU Act 1974.

The Vice-Chancellor has ordered to place the minutes before the next Syndicate.

As per the orders of the Vice Chancellor, the minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning and Development held at 10.30 a.m on 05.09.2022 in the Syndicate room (COPY APPENDED) is placed before the Syndicate for approval.

Item No.01.01: Work bill related to the works entrusted to the firms as Project Management Consultant (PMC)- proper guidelines for processing the bills-reg.

The Audit II section, while processing a work bill submitted by the University Engineer in connection with the construction of Staff Quarters at Kariavattom Campus which is entrusted to M/s WAPCOS as Project Management Consultant, has remarked that the work bill was not endorsed and countersigned by the competent authorities of the Engineering wing of the University at the designated places and the U.O attached does not mention anything about the MoU which entrust work to the firm M/s.WAPCOS as Project Management Consultant (PMC) and the method of submitting the bill and making payment to the contractor.

As so many issues raised related to auditing of these type of bills, Audit II section has requested to issue proper guidelines related to the processing and submission of bills for auditing and suggested to incorporate the following points while issuing guidelines.

- 1. The U O related to administrative sanction shall be issued mentioning about entrusting the work to the firm as Project Management Consultant and the MoU regarding this.
- 2. The discrepancies and corrections in the work bills submitted by the firm shall be rectified and counter signed by competent authorities of UE Sn.
- 3. Work bill shall be submitted for auditing after proper endorsement and countersignature by the competent authorities of the engineering division of the University.
- 4. GST amount claimed shall be detailed in the work bill.
- 5. The work order issued to the contractor shall be attached to the work bill.

The Audit II section <u>also requested to mention the conditions to make the entire system of processing Project Management Consultant (PMC) work bills transparent and foolproof</u>.

The Joint Registrar (Campus Administration) has remarked that it would be appropriate to incorporate the five points suggested by Audit II section while framing the guidelines in this matter.

The Finance Officer and the Registrar have approved the proposal.

The Vice-Chancellor has ordered to hold a meeting with FO section, Audit section (Palayam & Kariavattom), Engineering unit, Planning section and Cash section, for discussing the matter and entrusted the Pro-Vice-Chancellor for conducting the meeting. Accordingly, the meeting was conducted on 12.08.2022 at PVC's chamber.

The meeting discussed the matter in details and put forward recommendations as tabulated below.

The meeting also recommended to issue a fresh U.O specifying the above points as guidelines for processing the work bill related to the works which are entrusted to Project Management Consultant.

As per the orders of the Vice-Chancellor, the matter regarding the preparation of proper guidelines for the processing of work bills entrusted to Project Management Consultant alongwith the minutes of the meeting held on 12.08.2022 is placed before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning and Development for consideration and recommendation.

The Committee evaluated the 3 EOI and has recommended not to accept the EOI from DK Consultants, Ernakulam as the firm does not fulfill the eligibility criteria.

The other 2 EOIs satisfied the eligibility criteria and hence the committee accepted the 2 EOIs for further processing.

The lowest bid is from PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd., Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram (L1) for Rs. 35 Lakh.

Hence the committee recommended PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd., Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram (L1) for Rs. 35 Lakh. It is also recommended for negotiation with L1.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has approved the minutes of the meeting of the Evaluation Committee to evaluate the Expression of Interest for setting up Translational Research and Innovation Centre at the University of Kerala (TRIC-KU) and ordered to place the matter before the Standing Committee of Syndicate on Planning and Development on 05/09/2022 for consideration and to conduct a negotiation with the qualified firm who quoted the lowest.

Recommendation:

Negotiation was made with the PEMS Engineering Consultants, Pvt. Ltd., Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram (L1), in detail and the PEMS Engineering Consultants Pvt. Ltd. was directed to re-examine the bid amount quoted by the firm, in connection with the setting up of Translational Research and Innovation Centre at the University of Kerala (TRIC-KU), as the rate is not affordable.

Then the firm informed their willingness to reduce the offered rate to Rs. 30 lakhs (Rupees Thirty lakhs only).

The meeting directed the University Engineer to offer remarks on the revised rate amounting to Rs.30 lakhs (Rupees Thirty lakhs only) for the project quoted by the PEMS Engineering Consultants Pvt. Ltd. Then the University Engineer has furnished her remarks on the revised rate quoted by the firm as follows:

Item No.01.04:

Submission of Proposal for central assistance for the construction of hostels under the hostel component of the scheme of Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abyuday Yojana -reg.

Department of Social Justice and Empowerment had requested, vide letter dated 7/12/20, to conduct need based assessment exercise to assess the requirement of hostels under the scheme of Babu Jagjivan Ram Chhatrawas Yojana (BJRCY), which has now been merged into Pradhan Abhyundaya Yojana (PM-AJAY) as one of the components.

Higher Educational Institutions which are top ranked as per the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of the Government of India and fully or partially by the Centre/State/UT Government shall be eligible for funding under this component.

As per the guidelines, the proposal for construction / expansion / repair of hostels of the State Universities / Institutions shall be part of the Annual Action Plan of the respective State Government / UT Administration to be submitted to this Department under the Grants-in-Aid component of the scheme.

It is required to conduct a comprehensive need assessment exercise for sanction of central assistance for the construction of hostel/demand survey. The assessment / survey should focus upon fetching information on the following:

- 1. Number of operational hostels for SC students.
- 2. Number of SC students enrolled
- 3. Number of SC students availing hostel facilities
- 4. Number of SC day scholars
- 5. Gap in availability of hostels for SC students.
- 6. If a hostel is sanctioned, whether the institution has the required land for construction of hostel or not.
- 7. Willingness of the institutes to provide resources for management and day to day operation of the hostel.

In the meeting held on 1/8/2022 to finalize the proposal to be submitted under PMJVK, the University Engineer was entrusted to submit the proposal for construction of new hostel at Kariavattom campus.

For the need based assessment, it was suggested that the CSS be contacted to get the data. However, the CSS had no such data pertaining to the SC students. The data obtained from the Ad.DII section, based on the request for hostel facility (2021 Admissions), is appended herewith.

The University Engineer has submitted the proposal of construction of new hostel at Kariavattom campus for an amount of Rs.54,50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Four Crore Fifty Lakh only). It may be noted that, the amount of financial assistance has not been specified by the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment.

As per the orders of the Vice Chancellor, the proposal placed before the Standing Committee on Planning & Development for recommendation.

Recommendation:

- To entrust the University Engineer to submit a detailed project report for the construction of new hostel for girls (prioritising SC students) at Kariavattom campus with accommodation limited to 250 students, with immediate effect.
- To entrust IQAC to conduct a comprehensive need assessment exercise for sanction of central assistance for the construction of hostel /demand survey.

Resolution of the Syndicate

RESOLVED that the above recommendation of the meeting of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning and Development held on 05.09.2022, be approved.

Item No.01.05:

Setting up of Multimedia Classrooms & Multimedia Theatre Classrooms - Extension of Last date of completion of Civil, Electrical and Networking works, with or without fine - Consideration - reg.

The Special Syndicate at its meeting held on 08.10.2021 had resolved to award the Civil, Electrical and Networking components of works in connection with the setting up of Multimedia Theatre Classrooms and Multimedia Classrooms in the University Teaching Departments to M/s Macro Enterprises, Chennai by excluding the components AV Equipment and Server Storage System, for an amount of Rs.5,96,28,744/- (Rupees Five Crore Ninety Six Lakh Twenty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty Four only), plus tax except for the component Networking.

Later, vide U.O.No.Ad.BII/3415/2022/UOK dated 05.05.2022, the estimate was revised to Rs.7,27,45,164/- (Rupees Seven Crore Twenty Seven Lakh Forty Five Thousand One Hundred and Sixty Four only/-), based on the letter submitted by the University Engineer showing the additional requirements occurred during the works.

The Syndicate held on 07.07.2022 vide item No44.132 resolved to approve the recommendation of combined meeting of the Technical & Monitoring Committee of the multimedia classrooms, to finalize the last date of completion of Civil, Electrical and Networking works as 15.06.2022. Now, the University Engineer vide letter No.DB2/MM-Theatre class/MMC/22 dated 16-08-2022 has requested to clarify whether the extension granted is with or without fine for executing supplementary agreement for the time of extension and the University Engineer has also recommended not to impose fine on the firm, as the delay occurred was not entirely due to the fault of the firm.

Also, the firm M/s Macro Enterprises has requested to release 75% adhoc payment amounting to Rs.2,44,34,332/-, for the completed works. The Syndicate at its meeting held on 05.08.2022 resolved to approve the recommendation of the multimedia monitoring committee, to entrust the University Engineer to issue 75% of adhoc payment against the bill submitted by the firm M/s Macro Enterprises, after obtaining the certification from the Assistant Executive Engineers concerned.

As per the orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, the request of the University Engineer to clarify whether the extension granted is with or without fine for executing supplementary agreement for the time of extension to the firm, M/s Macro Enterprises, Chennai as the date for completion of work was extended up to 15.06.2022 and the request of the firm, M/s Macro Enterprises to release an amount of Rs.2,44,34,332 as 75% adhoc payment for the completed works are placed before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Planning & Development, for consideration and appropriate recommendation.

Recommendation:

- To execute supplementary agreement for the extension of time of completion of Civil, Electrical and Networking works in connection with the setting up of Multimedia Theatre Classrooms and Multimedia Classrooms in the University Teaching Departments, with M/s Macro Enterprises, Chennai, without fine, as the delay occurred was not entirely due to the fault of the firm.
- To levy fine on the delay occurred from the part of M/s Neuf Solutions in completing the AV related works in connection with the setting up of Multimedia Theatre Classrooms and Multimedia Classrooms in the University Teaching Departments, as per PWD norms.

 The meeting came to an end at 11.30 a.m.

Resolution of the Syndicate

Establishment of Geological museum and Rock Garden at Department of Geology at Kariavattom campus- Interior & Landscaping works- minutes of the meeting held on 27.08.2022 and concept note to the VIVID –Approval of -reg.

As per U.O dated 09.02.2021 sanction was accorded by the Vice-Chancellor to entrust Interactive Museum of Cultural History of Kerala (Kerala Museum), Keralam Museum of History and heritage, Park view, Tvpm approving the estimate amounting to Rs. 4,18,900/- (Rupees Four Lakh Eighteen Thousand and Nine Hundred only) (including GST @18%) submitted by Executive Director, Interactive Museum of Cultural History of Kerala (Kerala Museum), towards the preparation of DPR in respect of the interior and landscape works of Geological Museum & Rock Garden in the Department of Geology.

On the basis of the MoU, the Keralam Museum Authorities have conducted the final presentation (presented a narrative & Detailed Project Report) for the interior & landscaping works for the Geological Museum and Rock garden on 05.07.2022 in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Chamber, after incorporating the modifications in the concept theme and narrative suggested by the Department of Geology.

Accordingly, a meeting was held at 11.30 a.m. on 27.08.2022 at PVC's Chamber with Vision Varkala Infrastructure Development (VIVID) Corporation Ltd.

No. 1771/2013/H.Edn dated 26.08.2013, have accorded administrative sanction for a total amount of Rs 2 Crore (Rs 1Crore + Rs 1Crore) for the establishment of Geological Museum in the Department of Geology at Kariavattom Campus, University of Kerala. Accordingly, M/s. Iyer& Mahesh Architects, Thiruvananthapuram, the Architect consultant had completed the construction work of the building on 17.03.2020. (Photograph appended)

The Head, Department of Optoelectronics, vide Letter No. KU/OPTO/128/2022-23 dated 20/06/22, informed that the "Fluorolog-3 Spectrofluorometer" (Make: Horiba Scientific Instruments

Inc., USA) installed in the department, on 13th April 2018, purchased from the proprietary owner "M/s. Horiba Scientific Instruments Inc., USA" through the supplier firm "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore" (please see the U.O. dated 05/07/2017), with a warranty of three years from the date of installation, is not working properly. Hence the department requested the supplier firm, "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore" to inspect the instrument.

As per the service report obtained from the Service Engineer authorised by the supplier firm, it is informed that, the "Fluorescence software is not initializing", also "board, fluor timing control" and "5 wire modified for fluorolog 3" need to be replaced (Please see the copy of the Service Report appended in the file).

As the research activities of the Research Scholars and M.Phil students in the department are mainly dependent on this instrument, the Head has requested sanction for the replacement of the necessary parts of the equipment from the proprietary owner "M/s. Horiba Scientific Instruments Inc., USA" through the supplier firm "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore".

In this context, the Head, vide reference cited, has forwarded the quotation obtained from "M/s. Horiba Scientific Instruments Inc., USA" (through the supplier firm "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore"), along with a copy of the Service Report of the Engineer from the firm, the Minutes of the Department Council meeting held on 27/05/2022, recommending the purchase & the proprietary certificate from the supplier firm and requested sanction for replacing the faulty parts of the Equipment.

The Head, Department of Optoelectronics, has recommended the OEM "M/s. Horiba Scientific Instruments Inc., USA" (through the supplier firm "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore") for the replacement of the faulty "Board, Fluor Timing Control" and "5 Wire modified for Fluorolog" of the existing "Fluorolog-3 Spectrofluorometer", at a total cost of USD 4007.00 and requested to release an amount of Rs.3,25,000/- as provisional advance for effecting advance payment by 'wire transfer' to the above firm (inclusive of Customs Duty, Clearance Charges and provision for possible escalation in exchange rate) for finalizing the purchase of the corresponding spares of the equipment.

The expenditure for the replacement of parts shall be met from the h/a "Part II - Plan- MH 29-Department of Optoelectronics-4/1885 Development of Department (State)" of the current year's Budget Estimates of the University (SPG 2022-23).

In the quotation obtained from "M/s. Laser Spectra Services India Pvt. Ltd., Banglore", on behalf of the OEM "M/s. Horiba Scientific Instruments Inc., USA", it is also informed that, installation of these parts and checking performance of the Fluorolog-3 TCSPC system by "Morristec Laser Spectra Services Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore", is at a cost of Rs 26,000 /- plus 18% GST (i.e., a total of Rs.30,680/- (Rupees Thirty thousand six hundred and eighty only)).

The expenditure for the installation of spares and checking the performance of the "Fluorolog-3 Spectrofluorometer" system may be met from the h/a "Part I – Non Plan - MH 29-Department of Optoelectronics-4/3020 Maintenance of Equipment" of the current year's Budget Estimates of the University.

Being the foremost University in the state, it is likely that more institutions may request for such facilities of learning, in the days ahead. Hence, it is suggested to adopt a policy by the appropriate authority on such matters including Internships to students from institutions outside the University.'

Vide G.O (P). No.152/2020/Fin dtd.05.11.2020, the Govt of Kerala has limited the maximum period of LWA that can be sanctioned to an employee as **five years** within the total service period. A show cause memo dated 24.05.2022 was sent to Smt. Vidya S. on her non joining of duty, after the expiry of LWA on 31.03.2022. In reply, Smt. Vidya S. has informed that due to her personal problems and health issues, she is not in a position to join duty and has requested to grant more time for rejoining.

In the Circular No.83/2020/Fin dated 30.12.2020 issued by the Government, it is stated that vide G.O.(P). No.152/2020/Fin dt.05.11.2020, the Govt of Kerala has limited the maximum period of LWA that can be sanctioned to an employee as 5-years within the total service period. On completion of the leave, if the employee is not joining duty, disciplinary proceedings as envisaged in Rule-9, Appendix-XIIA and Rule-10, Appendix-XIIC of KSR Part-I needed to be imposed. Consequent amendments to this effect have been brought in the KSR Part I Rule 24 A and in Appendix XII A (Rule 6, Rule 10) and in Appendix XII C Rule 6 by substituting the words 20 Yrs with 5 yrs w.e.f. 5th day of November 2020.

According to Appendix-XIIA and Rule-10, Appendix-XIIC of KSR Part-I, "Those officers who absent themselves unauthorized without getting the leave sanctioned under rules as per KSR Vol-I shall be proceeded against and their service terminated after following the procedure laid down in the Kerala Civil Services (CCA) Rules 1960. Requests for re-entertainment in Govt service in such cases will be summarily rejected".

Item No.12 B.Ed Degree Course (2015 Scheme) – Request from Smt.Jaseela J.S to complete the Course -reg.

(Ac.AIII)

Smt. Jaseela J S, student of B.Ed Degree Course (2015 Scheme, 2017-19 batch) of KUCTE, Kariavattom had discontinued the course due to Maternity related issues. She had registered for the University examinations up to the third semester. Now 2015 scheme has elapsed and Scheme and Syllabus has been revised with effect from 2019 admission onwards.

As per the Regulations of the B.Ed Degree Course (Two year), "candidates can be given the provision of readmission as long as the Scheme exists. If the Scheme is over, candidates have to join the Course as fresh entrant". Hence, as per regulation the candidate is not eligible for readmission to the 2019 scheme.

The candidate has not undergone the Teaching practice programme in the fourth semester, which is a compulsory component of the course. The duration of the Teaching practice in fourth semester is 10 weeks. Also as per NCTE norms, Two year B.Ed students should undergo classes of 400 working days. Smt. Jaseela J S has completed 300 working days and should complete 100 more working days.

In a similar case of Smt. Manju Vengidesh, the candidate had filed a petition before the Honourable High Court of Kerala, Ernakulam (WP(c) No. 20050 of 2021. As per the Judgment dated 28/09/2021, a hearing was conducted on 28/09/2021. Her application was rejected after conducting Hearing, as it is against the existing Regulations. The Candidate again filed a new Petition WP © No. 10843 of 2022 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, to readmit her to the 2015 batch B.Ed Course at the Parent College and permit her to complete the studies by perusing 2015 Curriculum during the pendency of writ petition.

The Hon'ble Court vide Judgment dated 14/07/2022, in the WP (c) 10843/2022 ordered that the court will consider the matter on 09.08.2022; within which time, the competent authority of the University should consider the petitioner's case and inform the court what best can be done in the case. It may be noted that the Hon'ble Court has clarified that any decision to be taken by the University in terms of these directions will be only for the petitioner and will not operate as a precedent.

The Special Syndicate held on 05.08.2022 (Item No. 45) considered the matter and its decision is as follows:-

"The Hon'ble High Court vide Judgment dated 14.07.2022 ordered the competent authority to consider the case and inform the Court what best can be done in the case. In the light of the above facts, the Syndicate resolved to permit the candidate Smt. Manju Vengidesh to be readmitted to the 2015 Scheme B.Ed Course at her Parent College and permit her to write the examination as a special case.

Further resolved to intimate the decision of the Syndicate to the Hon'ble High Court with immediate effect"

In the final Judgment of Smt. Manju Vengidesh's case (08.08.2022), the Hon'ble Court has again clarified that the benefit of this Judgment will be ensured only to the petitioner and to no other person.

The Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academics and Research held on 16.08.2022 considered the request submitted by Smt. Jaseela J.S, and recommended to refer the matter to the Syndicate, along with the final judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala made earlier in a similar case and the resolution made accordingly by the Syndicate at its Special meeting held on 05.08.2022. The Syndicate at its meeting held on 25.08.2022 (Item no.45.90.D34) resolved to approve the above recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academics and Research held on 16.08.2022.

As per the orders of the Vice Chancellor, the matter regarding the B.Ed course (2015 Scheme) completion request of Smt. Jaseela J.S, is placed before the Syndicate consideration and decision.

Dr.Shiburaj S, Professor, Department of Botany (DBT), University of Kerala has submitted a proposal titled "Next Generation Nano Enabled Plant Protective Formulation" in association with Indian Institute of Technology-Madras (IITM) and McGill University, Canada in response to India-Canada Joint Call for Proposals (CFP) 2022 by DBT on Building Resilient and Carbon-Neutral Communities Post Covid.

This Multiple-Institutional project is with a total proposed outlay of Rs.1,48,00,000/- (Rupees One crore forty eight lakhs only) and has two years duration. The summary of the project is that a significant portion of the valuable crops are lost due to fungal attack every year globally. Though several approaches and policies have been adapted to overcome the loss, the detrimental effect and economic loss due to fungal pathogens are insufferable. The current proposal focuses on developing a water-in-water nanoemulsion fungicide formulation that helps the producers to overcome the problems associated with the conventional fungicides. The proposal also research the impact of COVID-19 has been felt disproportionally by remote and rural communities which prior to the pandemic had limited access to reliable infrastructure, secure food supplies clean water and access to health facilities.

Project funded in this Joint Call is expected to be of a high international standard that will lead to a technology solution directly impacting the lives of Indian and Canadian citizens. India-Canada joint projects must be based on meaningful engagement, include a project plan, and involve at least one researcher from Canada and one researcher from India.

The Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction to the project and the matter is reported to the Syndicate.

As per the details of statement regarding recovery of EPF amount forwarded by the Director, SCCPCK an amount of Rs.2,34,029/- (Rupees Two lakh thirty four thousand and twenty nine only) has to be recovered from the pension arrears payable to Smt. Mary Vimala (w/o Late Sri. William Johny), being the sum of principal and interest of EPF (Employer's contribution) in r/o Sri. William Johny. Hence after recovering the EPF Employer's contribution an amount of Rs.19,41,547/-(Nineteen lakhs forty one thousand five hundred and forty seven only) may be disbursed to Smt.Mary Vimala (21,75,576-2,34,029).

As per the details of statement regarding recovery of EPF amount forwarded by the Director, SCCPCK an amount of Rs.14,90,863 (Rs. Fourteen lakhs ninety thousand eight hundred and sixty three only) has to be recovered from Sri. C.G.Muraleedharan, being the sum of principal and interest of EPF (Employer's contribution). Item No.16.04 Enhancement of remuneration - contract staff of Scheme on Study on the Cost of Cultivation of Principal Crops in Kerala (SCCPCK), Kariavattom- reg:-

The Contract staff of SCCPCK (through the Director, SCCPCK) vide request dated 08/02/2022 submitted a proposal for enhancing the remuneration of the employees on contract basis in SCCPCK, Kariavattom. The SCCPCK is funded by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Govt.of India.

It is intimated that, the sponsoring body has already stated in its various communications that the consolidated amount of remuneration payable to 'contracted' personnel would be comparable to the salary admissible to the fresh recruits of that category. As per the above condition the remuneration of contract employees of Cost of Cultivation Scheme was revised vide U.O. No.AdF1/10637/2010 dated 23/01/2014.

As per the pay revision 2016, HRA and CCA were excluded and the pay admissible to the contract staff of the Kerala Government was implemented to the contract staff of SCCPCK. Hence the Staff of SCCPCK, Kariavattom requested to enhance the monthly remuneration of the contract employees of SCCPCK.

As per the Letter No.3-2/2008-CS-ES dated 27/06/2011, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare has intimated that "The consolidated amount of remuneration payable to contracted personnel would be comparable to the salary admissible to the fresh recruits of that category. As the employees under the CS scheme are governed by the rules and regulations of the concerned Universities and the instruction issued are being followed, this Department has no objection in the matter".

It may please be noted that, previously (02/11/2019) when the Director forwarded the request to enhance the remuneration of the employees on contract basis in SCCPCK, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor implemented the resolution of the Syndicate held on 28/07/2021 to approve the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance held on 16/07/2021 that the proposal may be considered along with the revision of remuneration of Contract Staff engaged in the University, as per the G.O P No .29/2021/Fin dated 11/02/2021.

Now, as per the remarks from Ad AV section, G.O P No .29/2021/Fin dated 11/02/2021 was implemented in the University vide U.O No .Ad AV.12762/2021/UOK dated 30/11/2021. The enhanced monthly remuneration of the contract employees of SCCPCK as per G.O (P)No.29/2021/Fin dated 11/02/2021 and U.O No .Ad AV.12762/2021/UOK dated 30/11/2021 is

(EG VI A)

The Faculty of Education, at its annual meeting held on 24.03.2022 recommended that before the exam registrations, Principals should ensure that the candidate has completed all the necessary components in the prescribed time and should keep a record and submit the same before the External Board, when it comes for commission. (During 4th Semester) The External Board should verify the report and random verification of the students records is also taken. The Academic Council at its meeting held on 01.04.2022 approved the said recommendation. A circular No. 11059/Ac AIII/2022/Uok, dated 27/05/2022 was also issued and circulated to all Colleges in this regard.

Later, as the above Circular lacked clarification regarding the academic year from which the mentioned verification by the External Board has to come in to effect and whether the students of 2020-22 batch need to present their documents/records in connection with first, second & third Semester B.Ed Degree Examinations before the External Board .

On Clarification, the Chairperson, BOS in Education (Pass) &Dean, Faculty of Education, has remarked that "the matter mentioned in the circular will be effective from 2020-22 batch B.Ed onwards"

Check Lists for documents to be verified in respect of Core Subject, Optional Subject & Physical Education, starting from the First Semester to Third Semester of 2020-2022 admission students were also forwarded by the Coordinating Chairmen, in tune with the said Circular.

In view of the fact that the Fourth semester B.Ed Degree Practical Examinations of 2020-22 batch is proposed to be commenced from 15/09/2022 to 30/09/2022, as per the direction of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, the following are placed before the Syndicate;

- (a) The decision of the Academic Council does not specify the date from which the new Regulation comes into effect. In such cases whether the new guidelines can be made applicable to students who were admitted in 2020
- (b) The Board constituted for Fourth semester Practical Examination has been asked to verify the documents related to previous semester examinations. Whether this may be considered in order.

The matter is placed before the Syndicate for consideration and decision.

Resultantly, the Honourable High court has directed the Syndicate of the University to consider the claim of the petitioner, if required, by enhancing the number of seats, adverting to the fact WP(C) NO. 26737 OF 2022 that she is Rank No.16 in the list of eligible candidates in the open quota, then stated to be eligible for the next seat. This shall be done not later than 28.09.2022 and if the Syndicate is unable to meet within the afore time frame, it will also be available to the Vice-Chancellor of the University to invoke his emergency powers for such purpose, subject to all other requirements being satisfied.

The matter was placed before the CSS Academic Committee held on 13/09/2022 vide item 7 and committee recommended to enhance the sanctioned strength of M.A Public Administration by two– for the Academic year 2022 only and to distribute 1 seat to General Open Merit and 1 seat to SEBC-Ezhava so as to admit the petitioner as per the Judgement of the Honourable High Court and further resolved to refer the above recommendation to the Syndicate .
