Applications are invited from the eligible research scholars of the University teaching departments for providing financial assistance for presenting papers in International Seminars as envisaged in the Budget Proposal 2019-2020, complying with the following conditions:

- The participation in International Seminars/Conferences/Symposiums conducted outside India during the period between 01.04.2019 to 31.03.2020 alone will be considered.
- The organizers of the International Seminars/Conferences/Symposiums identified for this purpose should be Universities, Governments, Statutory bodies, Professional bodies or internationally reputed agencies and organizations.
- International diversity among participants in the conclave is preferred (presence of at least 20% of the speakers (including contributed papers and invited papers) from outside the host nation is preferred).
- Applicants need to secure acceptance of their papers for presentation from the organizers and get the paper approved for funding from University of Kerala under this scheme by an approval committee constituted for this purpose.
- A candidate cannot apply for more than one International Seminar grant during the period of Ph.D. research programme and the maximum grant would be Rs. 25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only). The expenditure towards travel, accommodation and registration (if any) are eligible to be considered towards the award of this grant.
- Both Invited and Contributed (Oral) presentations in the international seminars/ conferences/symposiums are eligible under this scheme.
- Applicants should be Full-time/ Part-time research scholars of the University as on the date of application.

Application in the prescribed form along with the relevant details shall be forwarded by the HoD shall be submitted to the Director, IQAC on or before 15.02.2020
