About the Fellowship/Grant

The Centre grants postdoctoral research fellowships of Rs. 50,000 per month to scholars for a duration of one year.

Selection Criteria

The applicants must have a PhD degree within four years of its completion. They should have at least two publications in UGC CARE-listed/Scopus-indexed journals. They should demonstrate evidence of superior academic and professional engagement. They should demonstrate adequate knowledge of Latin American affairs. The applicants should submit a detailed proposal of their research work during the interview. The proposal should have the following components: statement of purpose, statement of the problem, significance of the topic and research gap, theoretical framework and methodology, work plan, and a list of 15 major books and articles related to the topic.
