

Kerala University is the mother University in Kerala and the Department of Psychology is one of the prestigious departments functioning from 1957 on ward under the faculty of Science. None of the Institutions offer short term or special training programme for clinical skills development or primary care of Psychological disorders. In this context, it is very essential to conduct programs to focus clinical skill development to better quality management of psychological problems with the assistance of well known Psychological intervention experts from reputed institutions of National importance to share their Scientific approaches in Psychological intervention strategies in the management of mental health problems.
