The University of Kerala, in connection with the Golden Jubilee of the Department of Sociology, is hosting the 45th All India Sociological Conference (45th AISC) at the Kariavattom Campus from 27th to 29th December 2019. The Theme of the Conference is, *Environment, Culture and Development: Discourses and Intersections*. In the context of the recent floods and environmental disasters that hit the State, there will be a special Plenary in the Conference on *Rebuilding Kerala: Technological and Environmental Challenges*. As part of this Plenary, we are organizing a Pre-Conference Condave on "Environment Management: Policies, Perspectives and Strategies", fucussing on the issues of Solid Waste Management.

The Conclave seeks to provide a platform for the technical Experts, environmentalists, social Activists, academicians, politicians, research Scholars and post graduate students to examine the challenges and prospects in implementing environment management projects, which could play a vital role in Rebuilding Kerala. The deliberations of the Conclave will be presnted in the Plenary at the Conference for further considerations and incorportated into the compiled report of the Plenary to be submitted to the Government, which it is hoped, will strengthen its efforts at Rebuilding Kerala.
