ORDER

The University of Kerala, in pursuance of the Ordinance cited (1) above, had issued notification cited (2) inviting applications for affiliation of new U.G. & P.G. courses in affiliated colleges to be considered within the 30 day window allowed for such consideration by the Syndicate not withstanding anything contained in the Statutes otherwise for purpose of being granted affiliation during the academic year 2020-21.

The Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Affiliation of Colleges vide paper read as (3) above, considered the applications received and recommended to conduct inspections in the colleges concerned by a team comprising Members of Syndicate and Subject Experts and nominated the Members of Syndicate to conduct the inspection. The recommendation was approved by the Vice-Chancellor and the same was reported to the Syndicate vide reference (5) above.

Vide paper read as (4), the Syndicate considered the reports of the inspection conducted and resolved to seek the views of Government as stipulated in Statute 9 in Chapter 24 of Kerala University First Statutes, 1977 relating to the granting of conditional affiliation to courses recommended by the respective inspection commissions to various colleges. The Government vide order read as (6) above accorded Administrative Sanction to start new courses in Government and Aided colleges. The Standing Committee of the Syndicate on

Affiliation of Colleges vide paper read as (7) above, considered the Government order and

recommended that conditional affiliation be granted only to the programmes recommended by the University for which favourable views have been obtained from Government. Further recommended that programmes/ colleges figuring in the Government Order but not forwarded by the University for views or are without approved Syllabus and Scheme need not be considered at present, and that Government be intimated accordingly. The recommendation was approved by the Vice-Chancellor and the same was reported to the Syndicate vide reference (8) above. The following programmes were sanctioned subject to the fulfillment of procedural formalities of affiliation.

Further, the Government vide order read as (12) above accorded Administrative Sanction to start new courses in nine more Aided colleges during the academic year 2020-21 which had already been recommended by the University. The Syndicate vide paper read as (13), considered the Government Order and resolved to grant conditional affiliation to the new programmes in nine Aided colleges as per the Government Order in which M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam was sanctioned with M.Sc. Statistics with specialization in Data Analytics programme. Further resolved to grant conditional affiliation subject to re-inspection with in ensuing six months, to the new courses for which the Government had given consent.

The Government vide order read as (14) above accorded Administrative Sanction for starting new courses in two more Government colleges viz., Govt. K.N.M. Arts and Science College, Kanjiramkulam and B.J.M. Govt. College, Chavara and one Aided college viz., M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam. In Government Order read as (14) it has been mentioned that B.A. Communicative English programme is sanctioned in place of M.Sc. Statistics with specialization in Data Analytics, but the same required more clarification from the Government as to whether the college authorities have submitted proper request for withdrawing the application for affiliation of M.Sc. Statistics with specialization in Data Analytics programme already sanctioned in the college. Accordingly the Vice Chancellor, on 26.02.02021, has ordered to defer the affiliation of the course granted to M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam, subject to reporting to the Syndicate.

Meanwhile, the Manager, M.S.M. Memorial College, Kayamkulam had submitted a request read as (15) to cancel the affiliation for M.Sc. Statistics with specialization in Data Analytics programme and to enable them to start the B.A. Communicative English programme during the academic year 2020-21 itself. The Syndicate vide paper read as (16), considered the matter and resolved to grant affiliation to M.Sc. Statistics with specialization in Data Analytics programme in M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam be treated as withdrawn in the light of the request submitted by the Manager and the matter be intimated to the Government. Further resolved to grant B.A. Communicative English programe in M.S.M. Memorial College, Kayamkulam as per Government Order dated 25.02.2021 and the matter be intimated to the Government. The following programmes were sanctioned subject to the

fulfillment of procedural formalities of affiliation.

The Educational Agencies of all the colleges mentioned in the above tables have fulfilled the procedural formalities as prescribed by the University.

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the University to grant Conditional Affiliation under Statute 12 in Chapter 24 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977, to above mentioned new courses including Innovative programmes in existing Affiliated Colleges for the academic year 2020-'21.

The Affiliation granted is provisional and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The admissions shall be made in accordance with the statutory regulations of the University and the State Government from time to time.
- 2. The management of the Institution shall not close the Institution or the institution shall not discontinue instruction in any course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the University.
- 3. No excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances.
- 4. The Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the same premises / campus and / or in the name of the Institution without prior permission / approval of University.
- 5. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students / guardians of students in any form
- 6. There shall not be any additional financial commitment on the part of the Government and the University.

7. The self financing Un-aided Colleges shall have to pay the Infrastructure Development and Maintenance fee before 31st March every year, in advance, as prescribed in the Ordinance, to provide service to these Course(s) as they are affiliated on condition that there will not be any additional financial commitment on the part of the Government / University.

8. All infrastructural and instructional facilities for higher semesters shall be made

available in time to ensure the quality of education provided.

9. The period of affiliation shall be one year/ till further orders by the University.

10. Further, the institution shall strictly follow all the provisions contained in the Kerala University Act, 1974, the statutes framed there under, and the regulations prescribed by the Central Regulatory Bodies viz., UGC, NCTE, AICTE, BCI etc. Any violation of the above shall call for liability upon the Educational Agency.

11. Continuance of affiliation to the new courses shall be granted only after conduct of

Re-inspection to verify compliance to the requirements noted by the University.

Orders are issued accordingly.
